2nd CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR DOCTORATE MOBILITY FROM BRAZIL TO EU

1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In order to apply for a Doctorate grant within the framework of the EMUNDUS15 programme, candidates must comply with the **following general requirements**:

- They must have Brazilian nationality and be registered in one of the Brazilian partner institutions included in this project.
- They must have sufficient knowledge of the language of the courses provided in the hosting universities. Only official certificates will be accepted as proof of knowledge.
- Students must have a Master degree, obtained in one of the eligible universities included in this programme.

2. GRANT

EMUNDUS will cover travel and insurance costs of beneficiaries and a monthly allowance of €1,500.

3. DURATION OF MOBILITY

The duration of the mobility will be 10 months.

4. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Brazilian candidates have to apply online through the EMUNDUS15 website, uploading the required supporting documents in the same application tool. All candidates must close their applications.

All candidates may apply for a **maximum of three hosting universities**.

3.1 Online Application Form

The online application form is only available in English. However, candidates have to submit all supporting documents in the official language of instruction of the hosting university, or failing that, in English. Candidates applying to several universities with different languages of instruction should submit their supporting documents in English.

3.2. Required documents

Candidates must attach to their application the following supporting documents:

- Copy of the passport of any other official identity document
- Curriculum Vitae _European CV (Europass)
- Language certificate(s)
- 2 Recommendation letters
- Motivation Letter (maximum 2 pages)
- Bachelor Certificate

- Bachelor Transcript of Records
- Master Certificate
- Master Transcript of Records
- Research proposal

3.3 Deadline

The online application form will be available from **25th February 2010 to 12th March 2010**, both days included. We cannot accept applications after this deadline.

6. SELECTION CRITERIA

Candidates will be ranked according to the criteria given below:

- **Priority fields of study (10%)**

EMUNDUS15 will allow participation of candidates from all fields of study offered by the partner institutions. However, priority will be given to the following specific fields of study:

- Education and Teacher Training
- Engineering and Technology
- Social Sciences

- **Academic background and Curriculum Vitae (40%)**

Evaluation based on academic records and suitability of Curriculum Vitae of the candidate.

- **Socio- economical disadvantaged situation (20%)**

To be considered as included in this situation, candidates must give proof of their economical disadvantaged situation.

- **Knowledge of language of host country (10%)**

Evaluation based on a certified level of the host institution language.

- **Correction mechanism applicable to guarantee gender and geographical balance (20%)**

This mechanism will be applied in the final selection of beneficiaries.
