We are pleased to announce the upcoming workshop on “Patterns of Membrane Protein Clustering (MPC) as a biomarker of mental disorders” that will take place at the USC CIMUS center on September 4th.

This workshop will focus on reviewing the current research on the discovery of novel biomarkers of mental disorders by analysing the patterns of membrane protein clustering in peripheral lymphocytes, and in discussing the next steps to carry out.

There is a necessity on providing novel tools to help a better diagnosis and use of the therapeutic arsenal for mental disorders, and the workshop will summarize the actual knowledge on research on biomarkers of mental disorders as well as highlight the activity of researchers studying MPC under the aegis of a memorandum of agreement signed by the University of Victoria (Canada), University of Saskatchewan (Canada), University of Santiago de Compostela (Spain), and the Galicia-Sur Biomedical Foundation (Canada).

The workshop has two sessions (see attached program) with the morning one being open to the public and we would like to cordially invite you and your students to the open session of the workshop.
